Archbishop Oscar Romero was killed – gunned down while celebrating the Eucharist – 35 years ago, on March 24, 1980. His death was the capstone of a courageous and passionate ministry of criticizing the injustices and violence that plagued his country, and of working for peaceful resolutions to the mayhem.

In 1977 he was named archbishop of San Salvador, the nation's capital. It was a time of deep social unrest and the move was seen as a victory for El Salvador's ruling class, because as a priest and bishop, Romero had shown no interest in supporting leftist activism, and he maintained good relations with the rich. But Archbishop Romero's disposition, especially toward the difficulties that stirred up Salvadoran society, was soon to change.

The final straw was his homily of March 23, 1980, insisting that members of the armed forces refuse any order that was contrary to the law of God. He pleaded directly with soldiers to keep in mind that they were killing their own people, and he concluded dramatically: "In the name of God, in the name of this suffering people whose cries rise to heaven more loudly each day, I implore you, I beg you, I order you in the name of God: stop the repression."

He was assassinated the next day – shot through the heart at long range – while he celebrated Mass in the chapel of Divine Providence Hospital. No killer has ever been brought to justice for the crime. The name most often associated with leading the attack is army Major Roberto D'Aubuisson. It is widely known that D'Aubuisson was also responsible for many other politically motivated kidnappings and murders around El Salvador during the late 1970s and early 1980s. He even earned the nickname "Blowtorch Bob" for his interrogation tactics. He died of cancer in 1992.

Romero knew his life was in danger. Several of his priests had been killed and many more tortured. He received death threats, and once an unexploded bomb was found beneath the pulpit in a church where he celebrated Mass the previous day. He rejected the offer of military bodyguards, saying, "I don't want protection as long as my people are not given protection. With them, I want to run all the risks that my vocation demands of me."

In one conversation with a newspaper reporter, he said, "Can you tell them, if they succeed in killing me, that I pardon and bless those who do it? But I wish that they could realize that they are wasting their time. A bishop may die, but the Church of God, which is the people, will never die."

En el evangelio de hoy estamos ante el episodio de los griegos. Jesús introduce la glorificación del Hijo del Hombre, con una serie de pronunciamientos abarrotados de vocabulario de gloria.

A la fiesta de Pascua subían hasta Jerusalén gentes de todo el mundo conocido. Y los piadosos judíos subían "a ver al Señor"; era el lenguaje del peregrinaje. Por eso, lo que los griegos le dicen a Felipe de "Queremos ver a Jesús", suena a gloria y adoración, pues sin duda que se da un empalme entre Dios y Jesús, que no se puede dejar de percibir. A estos griegos dispuestos a "verlo", Jesús les despliega el cuadro majestuoso de la glorificación del Mesías.

Ser glorificado significa para alguien ser reconocido y aclamado por las autoridades constituidas, por las conquistas o acciones heroicas benéficas para su pueblo. Así es como el héroe gana autoridad y mando. Jesús habla de su exaltación.

La imagen del grano de trigo que cae a tierra y muere figura el misterio pascual. El punto de la comparación no va en la línea de que el grano de trigo vuelve a vivir sino en su fecundidad. Sus abundantes frutos son la prueba más contundente de que su caída y muerte son glorificativas. Es decir, ensalzan, dan autoridad y poder a Jesús. Sin embargo, Jesús no ha muerto para resucitar. La muerte de Jesús sólo tiene sentido si es fecunda. Es decir, si es benéfica y productiva. ¿Cuáles son los frutos de su muerte?
