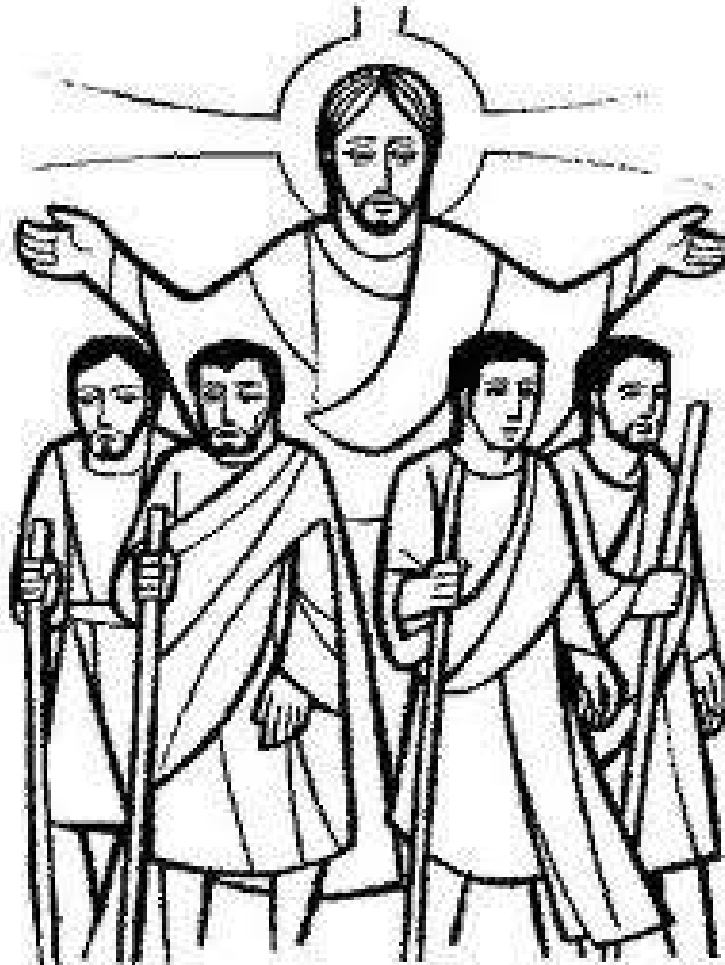

The theme of evangelization is relatively new in Catholic circles. “Evangelizing” is something we had long associated with Protestant groups that send their members door to door. We Catholics thought in terms of missions for the growth of the church, which meant sending a donation to clergy who travelled overseas.

In the documents of the Second Vatican Council (1962-65) however, one finds *evangelize* more than 200 times. This speaks of the act of spreading the Good News, sharing the life and message of Jesus Christ.

Pope Paul VI made evangelization a priority. When he issued “*Evangelii Nuntiandi*” (“On Evangelization in the Modern World”) in 1975, he lamented that all Catholics were neglecting their most basic duty.

What Paul VI identified as a matter of primary importance, John Paul II made a matter of urgency. He gave it a name, “the new evangelization,” and made it programmatic, focused and intentional. The new evangelization he said is “new” not in its content but in its inner thrust... “new” because of being necessary even in countries that have already received the proclamation of the Gospel.”

Pope Benedict said the new evangelization will be carried out not only by members of the clergy and missionaries, but by everyone in the church. It will not just end with initiation. It will be a summons to ongoing conversion. Catholics will strive to evangelize not only individuals but also culture and society, overcoming the currents of secularism that have caused many to lose their faith. It will evangelize the de-Christianized.

Writing 20 years ago Cardinal Avery Dulles wrote: “The church has become too introverted. If Catholics today are sometimes weak in their faith, this is partly because of their reluctance to share it.”

We need to get over this reluctance. We need to evangelize. The Mass reminds us that evangelization is a gift before it is a task. It is receiving before it is doing. We can share only what first we possess. At Eucharist we are nourished—for a reason—so that we can nourish one another.

## JÓVENES EN PEREGRINACIÓN A BRASIL



Millones de jóvenes serán recibidos en julio en Río de Janeiro, Brasil, por el Papa Francisco en su primera Jornada Mundial de la Juventud (JMJ) como Papa. Según la Conferencia de obispos católicos de Estados Unidos, la Jornada Mundial de la Juventud no es simplemente una reunión de jóvenes del mundo, sino un tiempo de poner la confianza en la juventud mundial. Es una llamada a que la juventud se una como pueblo.

En su homilía del Domingo de Ramos, el papa Francisco le dijo a los jóvenes reunidos en la Plaza de San Pedro en Roma, “Ustedes llevan la cruz peregrina por todos los continentes, por los caminos del mundo. La llevan como respuesta a la llamada de Jesús: “Vayan y hagan discípulos de todas las naciones”, que es el lema de la Jornada Mundial de la Juventud este año. La llevan para decirles a todos que en la cruz, Jesús abatió los muros de la enemistad que separan a pueblos y naciones y que trajo reconciliación y paz. Estamos ya casi listos para la nueva etapa de esta gran peregrinación de la cruz. Prepárense bien, prepárense espiritualmente y, sobre todo, en sus comunidades, para que su reunión en Río sea signo de fe para todo el mundo”.

El P. Gerardo Dondici Vieira, director del Departamento de Teología de la Universidad Ponticia de Río de Janeiro dijo que el tema de la JMJ es para musitar en el corazón, reflexionar y meditar. “Este tema, sobre hacer discípulos—llamar a otros discípulos a la comunión y la cercanía con el Señor—es el tema más querido del Evangelio de Mateo. Este mandato, esta misión, ya se ha anunciado en todo el evangelio. De hecho, sólo puede hacer discípulo de quien es ya discípulo, de quien vive en el Señor”.

Dondici añadió que este testimonio y proclamación del mismo Cristo son los mayores desafíos para la Iglesia, que vive en un mundo pluralista, con miles de piezas de información a través de las escuelas, el recreo, la internet y especialmente en contacto con las redes sociales, como Facebook y Twitter.

“Vivimos en un mundo en que se desperdicia mucho, se pierde la vida humana a causa de faltas de oportunidades. La cercanía del Señor nos trae lo mejor de nosotros mismos. El mandato, ‘Vayan y hagan discípulos de todas las naciones’ es un mandato para todo la vida. En ningún momento podemos tomar descanso porque asume que quien es amigo del Señor, por su vida y su manera de estar en el mundo, comunica a los demás la luz, la belleza y la alegría de ser discípulos del Señor. Ésta es la misión que necesita nuestra iglesia. Muchas veces nos quedamos paralizados y atónitos ante un mundo que se enloquece, pero en este mundo tenemos la presencia del Señor que nos ha escogido, que ha escogido a los jóvenes a ser signos de su amor y alegría en el mundo”, dijo el P. Dondici Vieira.

Los jóvenes que no puedan asistir a la JMJ, pueden asistir a esta celebración global reuniéndose en sus diócesis y parroquias para orar, reflexionar y prepararse espiritualmente, celebrar festivales de la juventud para compartir, ver y escuchar los mensajes que llegan de Río.
