TO GET IT

Should we here in Oceana County take to heart (Hart) Jesus' admonition to be a place where the "least of these" are respected and accorded basic human dignity? Of course, doing so takes deliberative effort. In an era when essential Medicaid funding is cut more and more every year, when many caregivers earn the minimum wage or less, caring for the least of these is not an easy path. Yet here in Hart we have an opportunity to reach out to those throughout the county with special needs and low income.

The plan for the Woodland Creek Apartments, on Tuesday, July 30 was denied 4-2 by the Hart City Council. Twenty-four rental units are planned. Twelve are to be for low income persons with physical or mental disabilities. Supportive staff would be on site eight hours each week; other agencies (Department of Social Services, COVE, Mercy Health Partners, for example) would be available depending on the need. There would also be units providing for low and very low income family supportive housing.

The Woodland Creek Apartments is a practical and compassionate response to a real need in our county. Further, Woodland Creek Apartments is a sign of hope, signifying a larger reality; God's love and the promise of welcome for the least among us.

Should we not support, in any way possible, moving this project forward?

PANORAMICA DE LA LITURGIA DE ESTE MES

La liturgia de agosto, en Tiempo Ordinario, está fuertemente marcada por la Asunción, en el centro del mes. El triunfo de María, que pertenece a la raza humana, invita a la misma atención a la que llaman las lecturas de los domingos de este mes. El domingo 18 (4 de agosto) es una invitación a considerar las cosas de arriba, es decir, el triunfo definitivo. En el domingo 19 (12 de agosto) se sigue insistiendo en la necesidad de estar atentos a lo que es esencial, al paso de Dios por nuestras vidas.

¿Cómo se vive considerando las cosas de arriba y con la atención centrada en Dios? Las respuestas vienen en los domingos siguientes: estando atentos a las cosas de abajo; es decir, a la vida diaria, al amor a quienes están a nuestro alrededor, a la justicia y a las obras de Dios. El triunfo definitivo humano, el que alcanzó María en su Asunción, pasa por el cuidado de la vida diaria, el servicio a los demás y los asuntos sociales.

Las fiestas de la Asunción tiene en muchos de nuestros países un carácter muy popular, ya que en muchos lugares adquiere diversas advocaciones (Begoña, Paloma, Azucena, Estrella).

La lista de los santos—los que también han alcanzado el triunfo porque anduvieron atentos a la vida diaria—que se celebran en agosto es larga y rica. Figuran en ella fundadores como Domingo de Guzmán, Alfonso Liguorio, Juan Eudes y Bernardo de Claraval; curas humildes, como Juan Vianney; los mártires claretianos, así como la maestra de escuela mártir Beata Victoria Díez. Ninguno de ellos fue rico en este mundo pero sí, como insiste la liturgia, atesoraron tesoros para Dios.

14 DE AGOSTO SAN MAXIMILIANO KOLBE

Los franciscanos se distinguen por su humildad y pobreza. Maximiliano se distinguió, además, por un heroísmo enorme. Era un fraile franciscano conventual, polaco, gran propagador de la devoción al Inmaculado Corazón de María, que había obtenido un doctorado en filosofía y otro en teología. Trabajó en Varsovia, creando una imprenta y casa editorial para difundir revistas católicas. Más tarde hizo lo mismo en Japón, donde fundó dos periódicos. Durante la Segunda Guerra Mundial, Maximiliano fue apresado y enviado a Auschwitz, el campo de concentración nazi. Allí una noche un preso se fugó y en represalia, los nazis iban a ejecutar a 10 de los demás presos. Maximiliano ofreció su vida a cambio de la de uno de los seleccionados, que era padre de familia. Fue enviado, con los otros nueve, a una celda de ayuno forzado hasta que muriera de hambre. Como no murió al cabo de unos días, le inyectaron fenol. Durante todo el tiempo en la celda, celebró misa diariamente. El hombre al que salvó la vida fue más tarde liberado y contó lo que había ocurrido.
