Being a news junkie, I'm usually up on current events. I note that many lesser known presidential

candidates warn against dynasties and look for an opening. Washington insiders hope for Bush versus Clinton, a back to the future strategy.

One thing can be counted on. A majority of Catholic voters will support the winner, as they have done in 10 of the last 11 presidential elections. Given the impact and diversity of Catholic voters, a key moment will be Pope Francis' address to congress this fall.

Pope Francis does not bring new doctrine, but new urgency and authenticity. He warns against obsessing on sexual morality in public life, without retreating from the obligation to protect unborn children, vulnerable elderly people and family life. His powerful metaphor of a "throwaway culture" offers new context to defend the lives and dignity of all to care for God's creation.

Indeed, American Catholics must be challenged to reject the intrinsic evils of abortion, euthanasia, torture and racism. These evils continue with a million abortions a year, advocacy of assisted suicide, debates on torture, and divisions on racial injustice.

There must also be affirmative challenges to care for the poor, to promote family life, and to pursue peace and justice. "Everyday Americans" without a moral priority for those at the bottom can expect to be challenged. Catholics should join Pope Francis in looking at economics and politics from the bottom up and the outside in; needed counterpoints to the Washington status quo. For Christians, poll-tested rhetoric about the "forgotten middle class" should yield to the soul-testing measure of care for "the least of these."

Also, the killing and persecution of Christians and others because of their faith demand much greater priority. There will likely be a papal challenge for the need of urgent action to protect the lives of believers around the world.

Pope Francis' description of the political vocation of Catholics is: "Catholics tasked with the political life must keep the values of their religion before them, but with a mature conscience and competence to realize them."

A menudo asociamos cumbres y lugares altos con lugares sagrados; para los peruanos puede ser el pico Machu Pichu; para mexicanos o guatemaltecos, se puede tratar de pirámides. El mirar hacia arriba hace que la vista se aleje de otros diosillos más pequeños y del mundo y vaya al encuentro de un Dios más alto, más trascendente. Hacerse ídolos es fácil y a veces casi inconsciente: consiste en concentrar la atención, el amor y el tiempo en algo que no es Dios ni lleva a Dios, como puede ser el dinero, una afición a un juego, el trabajo, el propio prestigio... y quedarse con la vista baja, mirando a lo que es, en realidad, el suelo. Esos dioses no duran; pasan tan rápido como se pusieron ante nuestros ojos; y, a la larga, no satisfacen. Nos hacen, en lugar de más grandes, mucho más pequeños y limitados. Nos encierran en nosotros mismos. Nos hacen confiar únicamente en nosotros mismos y, al final, si hay un fracaso, nos hundan en la frustración o en la depresión.



Nosotros estamos hechos para algo mucho más grande; como nos dice la primera lectura hoy, lo que ha hecho Dios con nosotros es enorme e inigualable. Existe un solo Dios al que merece la pena seguir y ése es el Dios que nos ama personalmente y nos llama, y nos concede toda fuerza y gracia. Lo demás es locura, porque sólo conduce a la tristeza.

Dios nos llama y nos elige por su inmenso amor. Es Él quien nos regala la fuerza para luchar en la vida, por difícil que sea. Es Él quien nos hace capaces de ver y reconocer el amor y levanta nuestra Mirada y nuestro corazón hacia algo más grande. Es Él quien nos concede la enorme dignidad de poder llamarnos y reconocernos como sus hijos.

Este reconocimiento y adoración del único Dios verdadero, como a los discípulos, nos cambia totalmente la vida: Podemos ahora entregar amor a otros, sin quedarnos vacíos. Podemos crear un sistema de relaciones con nuestros familiares y con los demás en los que la atención, el servicio, la entrega y la generosidad sean la norma. Podemos crear familias, como dice el lema del Encuentro Internacional de Familias que tendrá lugar en septiembre de este mismo año, con la misión de amar; y eso nos dará una alegría mucho mayor que las pequeñas y mezquinas satisfacciones que nos dan los diosillos del poder o del dinero.

El Señor ha estado grande con nosotros y estamos alegres.
