On this weekend as we celebrate the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ I am reminded of our oldest tradition: At Eucharist we receive the bread and the cup. These are not simply two alternate ways of receiving the Lord. Each has its own particular meaning.

We've been talking about what the cup meant to Jesus and means to us. When we stand before the cup, we hear the echo of when Jesus asks James and John, "Can you drink the cup that I drink?"... and we hear the echo of how you and I can become one with God by offering to God the blood of God's Son in today's moving Gospel from Mark: "He took a cup, and when he had given thanks he gave it to the twelve, and they all drank of it. And he said to them: 'This is my blood of the new covenant.'" And we hear the echo of the words of Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane, "Father, take this cup away from me, but not what I will but what you will." And with the echo of those words ringing within us, we say: "Amen." We say in effect, "Lord, if you are with me, I can. I will. Then we join with him, and take the cup, and by doing so we say: "Yes, Lord, I will do whatever I need to do to live out my faith. I will stay the course, and I will see it through."

Christians did that for a thousand years, but then it started to falter and, for many mixed reasons, the cup was not even offered to them. But now this ancient ritual has been restored to its rightful place. So I encourage you to turn a new corner in your life. If you don't drink from the cup, start doing it. I ask you to listen to the Lord saying to us, "Can you drink the cup that I drink?"... and you say, "Yes."

I don't want to put anyone on the spot or expect you to turn this corner in one instant. And you should know that if there's an immediate threat of the flu, or some illness, the cup will not be offered. And if you are ill you should refrain from receiving the cup. But I ask you, to become one with God by offering to God the blood of the Son, to begin coming forward to receive the cup.

- \*God is like Maxwell House... Good to the very last drop.
- \*God is like Bounty. He is the quicker picker upper. Can handle the tough jobs. And he won't fall apart on you.
- \*God is like the Energizer Bunny. He keeps going, and going, and going.



El mes de junio abre con alimento para el Cuerpo y la Iglesia, y cierra con la fiesta de San Pedro y San Pablo, con otra referencia fuerte al sentido de Iglesia; pero las lecturas de todo este mes, en Tiempo Ordinario, están muy acordes para una catequesis familiar al acercarnos cada vez más a la celebración del Encuentro Mundial de Familias en septiembre de este año. Todas las lecturas nos van adentrando, en realidad, en lo que es vivir en familia: pensar en los detalles; ofrecer un amor desinteresado y generoso, atento a las necesidades de los demás; dar vida y alimentar esa vida, como en la lectura de la hija de Jairo. Se trata de escuchar la Palabra desde ese ángulo práctico y concreto de la vida diaria, de lo cotidiano. Dar vida es escuchar a otros, valorarlos, apoyarlos en sus luchas y sus aspiraciones, educar, compartir. Dar vida es dar el alimento diario del cariño. De esto es de lo que nos hablan las lecturas de este mes. Es, además, como se nos dice en la fiesta de San Pedro y San Pablo, escuchar que somos hijos en el único Hijo, Jesús, cuando se nos pregunta: ustedes, ¿quién dicen que soy yo? Es decir, en todas las lecturas, es ser familia.

Se celebran en este mes, además, dos fiestas importantes, que siguen muy apropiadamente al día del Corpus: el Sagrado Corazón de Jesús y el Inmaculado Corazón de María, en el Viernes y sábado que siguen a la fiesta del Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo. Hay varios santos importantes, como san José Anchieta, evangelizador de Brasil, y el Nacimiento de san Juan Bautista, patrón de Puerto Rico. Se celebran además fiestas de varios mártires de los primeros tiempos del cristianismo, como san Ireneo, y los primeros mártires de la Iglesia de Roma. No hay muchas celebraciones de Nuestra Señora, pero sí una de gran importancia y devoción, que es Nuestra Señora del Perpetuo Socorro, el día 27.

#### San José de Anchieta

Nacido en las Islas Canarias, España, ingresó en la Compañía de Jesús cuando tenía 17 años. Estudió en la Universidad de Coimbra, Portugal. Pronto fue enviado a San Vicente, en Brasil, donde inició una catequesis con indígenas tupis. Aprendió el idioma y evangelizó a través de la poesía. Incansable trabajador, fue lingüista, médico, arquitecto, ingeniero y humanista y se le considera el padre de la literatura brasileña. Estableció escuelas para indígenas y, enviado por la Compañía a Río de Janeiro, fundó allí el primer colegio universitario y el primer hospital. Por un tiempo, fue superior de los jesuitas en Brasil.



Es considerado fundador de la ciudad de Sao Paulo y uno de los fundadores de Río de Janeiro. Murió a los 63 años el 9 de junio de 1597. Su labor de evangelización ha dejado una huella imborrable en todo Brasil.
